

**1. Q. What types of scholarships are available from NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL?**

A. NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL provides scholarships for use in four categories—Academics, Arts, Athletics, and Other.

**2. Q. How are scholarships funded?**

A. NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL scholarships are a service that NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL provides to its members in the homeschool community who find themselves in temporary need. Scholarships are funded from NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL funds *as resources are available*.

**3. Q. Can I donate to the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Scholarship Fund?**

A. Yes! NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Individuals and businesses can donate to NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL in general, or specify the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Scholarship Fund. All donations are tax-deductible.

**4. Q. Is there a set amount for scholarship awards?**

A. No specific amounts have been assigned. Each application will be considered on an individual basis.

**5. Q. What is the timeline for submission of applications?**

A. Scholarship applications may be submitted year round—*as your needs arise*.

**6. Q. How and when will I be notified of the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Board's decision?**

A. You will be notified in writing of the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Board's scholarship decision within 60 days of submittal.

**7. Q. What happens to the applications?**

A. All applications and supporting documentation are retained by the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL in accordance the requirements of our non-profit status. Files are maintained in confidence and are accessible to NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Board members only.

**8. Q. Where do I get an application?**

A. You may download a NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Scholarship Application from the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL website [www.nebraskahomeschool.org](http://www.nebraskahomeschool.org) or request a copy by contacting NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL via email or via US postal mail at *NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL, PO Box 323, Boys Town, NE 68010*.

**9. Q. What if NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL can't meet my need?**

A. If your request is beyond the scope or ability of the NEBRASKA HOMESCHOOL Scholarship Program, we will refer you to the Home School Foundation. The Home School Foundation is the charitable arm of the Home School Legal Defense Association (HSLDA). The Home School Foundation grant assistance based on specific eligibility criteria. HSF's mission is to assist homeschool families with *essential needs* so they can keep on homeschooling. You don't need a referral—you may contact them at *any time*.
