Judge Eligibility – most any adult is qualified to serve as a judge. In fact, we desire feedback from a variety of community judges with varied backgrounds, experiences, and viewpoints. Students rely on your valuable feedback for improvement, growth, and encouragement. No prior judging experience is required. Judges must be at least 18 years old and not enrolled in high school.

Time Commitment – judging each round of speech or debate is approximately a 3-hour commitment which includes a judge orientation. You may judge as little as one round on one day or as many as your schedule allows over all three days. *Complimentary beverages and refreshments will be provided.*
