

The Congressional App Challenge is a nationwide coding competition that provides students the opportunity to engage in the exciting field of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). Students will develop a unique software application, or "app", for mobile, tablet, web or other computer-based platform. Winners are invited to attend a recognition ceremony in Washington, D.C. and possibly receive prizes.

The Congressional App Challenge is open to all middle and high school students living or attending school in Nebraska's Second Congressional District. Students who wish to enter the competition must submit their app online by October 15, 2018, including with it a YouTube or VIMEO clip demonstrating and explaining their app and what they learned through the development process.

Participation and Registration:

Who can participate?

Any middle or high student living or attending school in the Nebraska's Second District may enter the competition. If submitting as a team, all members must meet the eligibility requirements for individual contestants.

How do I register?

Create either a team or an individual account at <u>CongressionalAppChallenge.us</u> and then indicate your Member of Congress on the registration form provided. Registrations must be received by **September 10, 2018**.

All entries must be original in concept, design, and execution.
