Helpful hints to get the most out of your visit:

- 1) If your paperwork is complete:
 - Drop by and turn it in
 - Be sure to make a copy for your home files *beforehand*
- 2) If your paperwork is not complete:
 - Review the Exempt School Rule
 - Prepare a list of questions ahead of time (feel free to ask us first)
 - Complete as much of the paperwork as you can
 - Leave an item blank if you have a question so NDE staff can assist you
- 3) First-time filers (i.e. first year of homeschool for a child *in Nebraska*):
 - Bring your child's original birth certificate **AND** a legible copy
 - NDE staff can verify the copy that day and send you home with the original
- 4) Get your questions answered about online filing
