Contest Rules

Students must create a poster that demonstrates the theme:

“Bringing Our Missing Children Home”

1. Applicants must be in the fifth grade.
2. The new slogan **“Bringing Our Missing Children Home”** must appear somewhere on the poster.
3. Posters must be created by hand. Posters with printed images, collages, and stamping are not eligible.
4. Posters should be original in design. Be creative! Use acrylics, watercolor, pencil, charcoal, magic markers, spray paint, crayons, pastels, and etc.
5. The finished poster must measure 8½ x 14 inches.
6. The poster must be submitted with a completed application, which includes a description of the poster and a brief biography of the artist, either typed or written legibly, as well as the Parent/Guardian Release and Consent Form.

Posters must include,

“Bringing Our Missing Children Home”

or will not be eligible.

Posters must be postmarked by February 15, 2021.
