The Congressional Youth Advisory Academy is non-partisan youth program designed to educate students on how Congress operates and the process by which public policies are formed. The goal of the Congressional Youth Advisory Academy is to foster interest in a lifetime commitment to civic engagement and community service. This Academy will provide the student members with the unique opportunity to connect with other peers, government members and community leaders.

The Academy will be comprised of one Student Council member from each school chosen by the students as a representative. Congressman Bacon hopes to student members as they have already been elected to represent the entire student body. Once a representative has been selected by their on the Student Council, he or she will fill out an application form and return it to Congressman Bacon's Omaha office.

Student representatives will be expected to attend all four sessions of the Academy which will be held each Friday morning in June of 2021. The Congressional Youth Advisory Academy will be held on the campus of the University of Nebraska at Omaha from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.
